TOURNAMENT RULES

The Casco Bay Anglers Club's (CBAC) mission is to promote angling excellence on Casco Bay through camaraderie, education, competition and community involvement.

From an angler's perspective, Casco Bay is a resource of world class dimension. The varied and vast marine estuaries offer anglers a variety of fishing options and experiences. Whether you enjoy wielding a 9 wt fly rod casting crab patterns on a flat, or prefer light spinning tackle when hunting stripers, the opportunities Casco Bay offers are limitless. The CBAC encourages access to fishing experiences and works to serve as a voice of the Casco Bay region's angling community.



The CBAC clubhouse is located at 231 Front Street on the South Portland waterfront adjacent to the Saltwater Grille and Sunset Marina. The CBAC is a Maine, non-profit corporation with a dedicated, private membership.



The largest single fish in each of the divisions wins the grand prizes, which includes:

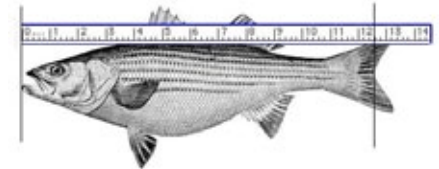

Location: Casco Bay, Maine

Format: A team shall consist of one or two anglers. The teams compete in one of two divisions: (1) The "Lefty Kreh" Division (Fly-rodders), or (2) The "Frank Mundus" Division (non-fly tackle).

Scoring: The competition is "catch and release". All fish must be measured along the lateral line from the tip of the lower jaw to the fork of the Caudal Fin. All entrants will be provided (at the "Striper Hunt Kick Off Party") the tournament ruler against which the size of the fish must be documented by digital photo.



The largest single striper in each of the fly and spinning divisions wins their respective division prizes, which includes a cash purse and a fishing package. The largest striper among the division champions is the Grand Champion, winning an additional cash purse and of course, the bragging rights attendant to being immortalized on the Casco Bay Striper Hunt Trophy. Prizes will also be awarded to the first and second runners up within each division.

Method: The Casco Bay Striper Hunt is a Catch & Release Tournament. All participating anglers are encouraged to release all stripers they land, but are not prohibited from taking a legal striper for personal consumption. Tournament participants may fish with bait, artificial lures and flies. IGFA fly fishing rules apply to the Lefty Kreh Division.

Fishing Time: Pre-dawn (12:01 a.m. on the 30th), to Noon (12:00 p.m. on the 31st). Official "Striper Hunt Scorecards" must be submitted on Sunday by noon. **The mandatory kick-off Captain's Dinner will be held at the CBAC Clubhouse (231 Front Street, South Portland) at 6:00 p.m. on Friday, July, 29, 2011. The dinner is included as part of your entry fee. Additional attendees can purchase tickets at the door.**
